YOUR CHANCE TO SHAPE THE FUTURE OF LTPs

The re-booting of the Local Transport Plan process is an important part of the Department for Transport's current programme. It will re-energise and enhance the role of LTPs.

This event will act as a mode of early stage outreach for the Department prior to its draft new LTP guidance. It will provide an opportunity for professionals in the sector to air their thoughts on how to help the next wave of LTPs play a key role in shaping local transport that suits both movement needs, and the wider relationship of transport to the other demanding economic, social and environmental issues both already in play and for the future. This will include their contribution to net zero through a planned new framework to achieve quantifiable carbon reductions which will be unveiled by the DfT at the event.

Participation is invited by transport professionals and politicians at all levels, from local authorities, STBs and mayors and transport consultancies to give their thoughts and suggestions ahead of the new draft guidance now being prepared. The event will provide an independent and well-informed forum at which the DfT will be in both presenting and listening modes.

- **Welcomes from LTT, DfT, and UTG**
- **Introductory presentation by Professor Peter Jones** on the history and role of LTPs within the transport policy and delivery framework and in meeting future transport challenges
- **Re-imagining LTPs** - how will the advice/roll out process work and timelines, and what new elements will be included in LTPs? - Speaker from DfT
- **Panel Discussion** on the broad ingredients/approach that can best be pursued in the new Generation of LTPs
- **Embracing Key policy driver 1** - Net Zero/decarbonisation
- **Embracing Key policy driver 2** - Levelling up and inclusive economic and social development
- **Embracing key policy driver 3** - Linking transport and wider planning and development issues

- **Panel Discussion** including transport bodies, consultants and campaigners
- **Response from DfT and next steps in the LTP process**
